
An Aspect-Oriented Implementation Method

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Benefits:

- Guarantees the effort given to requirements and design
- Guidelines to aspect-oriented development
- Guidelines to aspect-oriented refactoring
- Two implementation approaches
 - Experimentation for analysis
- Tool support
 - Aspect and classes generation
 - Increased productivity

Drawbacks:

- Interferences between aspects
- Taylored to a specific software architecture
 - Allows implementing several kinds of systems
 - Used in several real systems
 - More precise guidelines









Non-progressive approach
