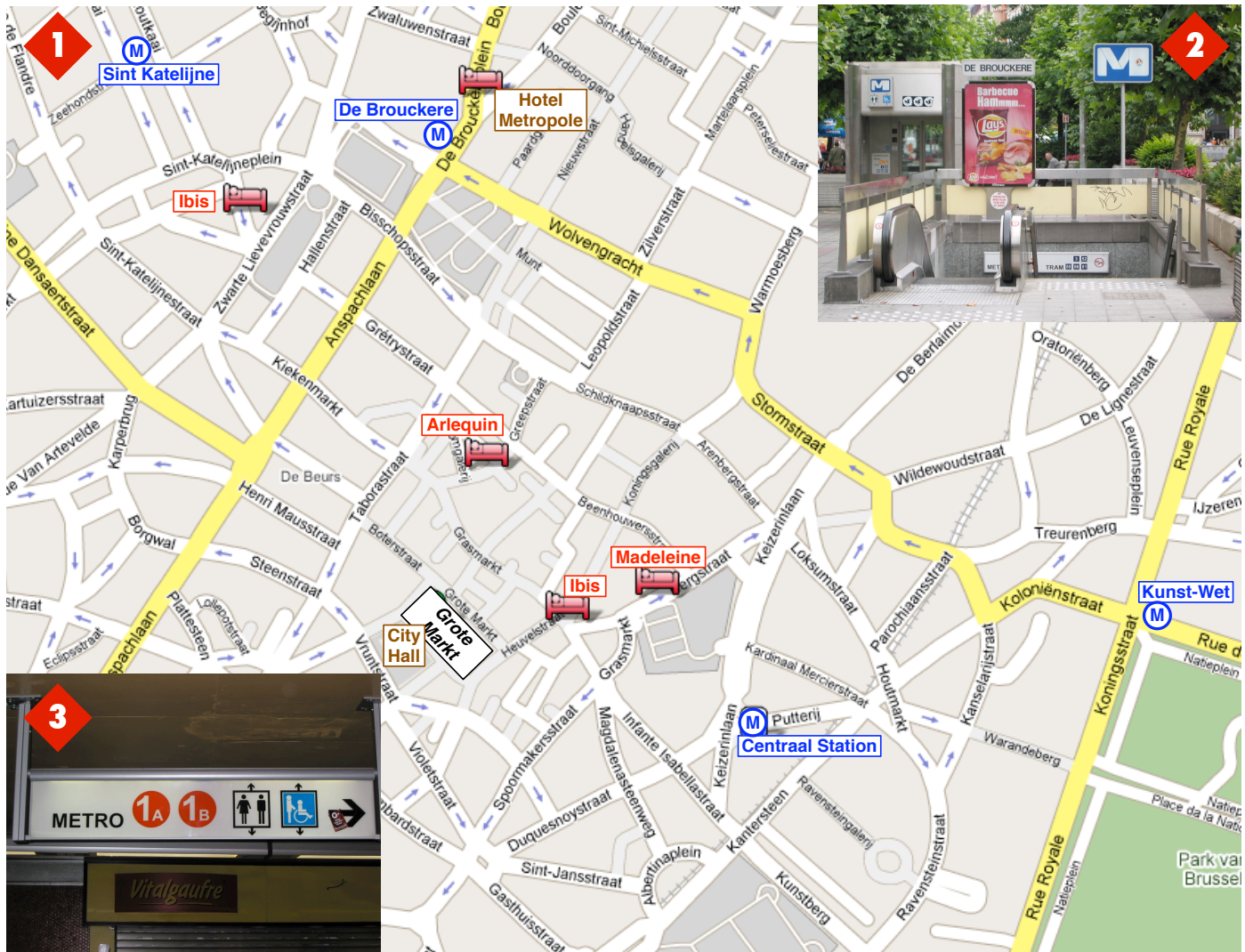


AOSD 2008 Directions

Dear AOSD Participant,

Below you find some directions that will help you get from your hotel to the university campus where AOSD 2008 is held. A numbered picture illustrates each step. It will take about 20 to 30 minutes to reach the campus by public transportation.



1. Use the map above to walk from your hotel to the nearest metro station.
2. Brussels' metro stations resemble the one shown in picture 2. At the metro station, you can buy a ticket from the vending machine or the attendant; just get one for a single ride as other tickets will be provided in your conference pack. You need to get the ticket stamped in one of the "orange machines" before crossing the red line.
3. Follow the signs leading you to metro lines "1a" and "1b" marked by orange circles. Make sure that you take the stairs down to the right platform: you need to take line "1a" in the direction of "Hermann-Debroux". Watch out that you don't get on a "1b" metro to "Stockel" which also stops at this platform. The destination of a train is clearly indicated on the platform, as well as on the front of the train itself.

4. Get off the train at station "Petillon", turn left and follow the signs to the "Vrijwilligerslaan" ("Avenue des Volontaires") exit.
5. When you exit the station turn to your right and follow the "Vrijwilligerslaan" ("Avenue des Volontaires") street straight on.
6. At the first square with traffic lights just continue straight on to the "Schoofslaan" ("Avenue Henri Schoofs") street.
7. At the next crossing, you are standing in front of the VUB campus. Cross the street and enter the campus. Follow the "AOSD Conference" and "Aula Q" signs towards the conference venue.
8. You can enter the conference venue through the "Nelson Mandela" entrance.
